

## Information/consent regarding check of public records

OKG is responsible for the security of operations at its nuclear power plants. We utilise a number of tools and procedures to achieve adequate security according to directions SSMFS 2005:1.

The Security Protection Act requires that you are given information and that you give your consent to a check of public records.

The check in question will be made in compliance with §14 of the Security Protection Act, which deals with protection against terrorism.

The check covers personal data that is available in:

- Records of the Security Service at Swedish nationally board
- Criminal Records and Records of Suspected Persons regarding sentence or suspicion in relation to certain sections of the criminal code
- Violation of the Criminal Code in connection with narcotics
- Violation of the Weapons Act
